### Judicial Retention Survey: Alaska Bar Association Members

**Technical Report** 

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*April 19, 2016* Revised June 30, 2016

Funded by Alaska Judicial Council

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#### Executive Summary

Alaska statutes require the Alaska Judicial Council to evaluate Alaska justices and judges eligible to stand for retention election. This survey was conducted among Alaska Bar Association members to obtain information about their direct professional and other relevant experience with the judges and their assessments of judicial performance. This 2016 retention survey included 2 supreme court justices, 1 appeals court judge, and 30 trial court judges eligible for retention.

The Alaska Judicial Council asked bar members to evaluate the justices and judges on six characteristics: *Legal Ability, Impartiality/Fairness, Integrity, Judicial Temperament, Diligence, and Overall Rating.* The rating scale ranged from *Poor* (1) to *Excellent* (5).

Table 1 shows the mean ratings for each justice/judge by respondents with direct professional experience on all six characteristics. Within each district, superior court judges appear first and are followed by district court judges.

### Judicial Retention Survey: Alaska Bar Association Members

#### Introduction

Alaska statutes require that the Alaska Judicial Council evaluate justices and judges standing for retention in an election year. The Council makes a recommendation to the State's voters to either retain or not retain each justice and judge. As part of the information used to fulfill its mandate, the Judicial Council distributed surveys to Alaska Bar Association members and asked them to rate justices/judges on six characteristics: *Legal Ability, Impartiality/Fairness, Integrity, Judicial Temperament, Diligence,* and *Overall Rating.* Each survey also contained demographic questions about the respondents, including type of practice, length of Alaska practice, gender, types of cases handled, and primary location of practice.

To maintain objectivity, the Council contracted with the Center for Behavioral Health Research and Services (CBHRS), a research workgroup at the University of Alaska Anchorage. CBHRS was responsible for all aspects of distribution and data collection related to the online version of the survey. Parallel paper surveys were printed and mailed by the Judicial Council but returned directly to CBHRS for processing, data entry, and analysis. CBHRS prepared this report summarizing survey procedures and results.

The 2016 retention survey included 2 supreme court justices, 1 appeals court judge, and 30 trial court judges eligible for retention.

### Methodology

All active in-state members of the Alaska Bar Association were invited to participate in this survey. Inactive and retired members and active out-of-state members were also invited to participate in the survey if the Council had email addresses for them. Of the 3,502 individuals invited to participate, the vast majority of individuals (3,350) received only an email invitation to complete the survey online. Fifty-five (55) individuals received only a paper version of the survey and 97 individuals received both the paper and online versions of the survey.

Respondents initiated 994 online surveys. Two surveys were excluded because the respondent answered "No" to the question certifying that they had complied with the ethical standards set out in Professional Rule 8.2 and 29 surveys were excluded because the respondents did not progress far enough in the survey to reach the certification question. Two online surveys were excluded because the respondents also returned paper surveys that were retained because the paper survey was dated earlier than the online survey was initiated (in one case) or because the undated paper survey was more complete than the online survey (in the second case). Therefore, 961 online surveys qualified for analysis.

Respondents also returned 35 paper surveys. No paper surveys were unsigned. Four paper surveys were excluded either because the respondents answered "No" to the question certifying that they had complied with the ethical standards set out on Professional Rule 8.2 or because they left that question blank. One paper survey was returned with signature but was otherwise completely blank. Three paper surveys were returned by individuals who also completed the

online survey. In one case, the online survey was initiated earlier than the paper survey was dated; thus, the online survey was retained while the paper survey was removed from analysis. In the other two cases, the paper survey was retained while the online survey was removed from analyses. Therefore, 29 paper surveys qualified for analysis.

The final analysis included 961 online surveys and 29 paper surveys, for a total of 990 surveys and a survey return rate of 28.3%. Of the 990 returned surveys, 120 respondents did not rate any of the justices/judges; 870 (87.9%) respondents evaluated one or more justices/judges. Table 2 summarizes the demographic characteristics of the respondents.

#### Instrumentation

The survey contained the names of the justices/judges eligible for retention, questions about demographic information for each respondent, six evaluation items for each justice/judge, and space for respondents to provide additional comments regarding each justice/judge. Both versions of the survey required a certification by the respondent that he/she had rated the justices/judges as required by the bar's Professional Rule 8.2. Instructions regarding the certification were provided:

"Please refer to Professional Conduct Rule 8.2 concerning your obligation to provide truthful and candid opinions on the qualifications or integrity of these judges."

Respondents evaluated justices/judges in six areas of performance. Detailed instructions for each domain were provided:

- *Legal Ability:* Please evaluate the justice's/judge's legal and factual analysis including the justice's/judge's knowledge of substantive law, evidence, and procedure, and the justice's/judge's writing clarity and precision.
- *Impartiality/Fairness*: Please evaluate the justice's/judge's sense of basic fairness and justice and whether the justice/judge treats all parties equally.
- *Integrity:* Please evaluate whether the justice's/judge's conduct is free from impropriety or appearance of impropriety and whether the justice/judge makes decisions without regard to possible public criticism.
- *Judicial Temperament:* Please evaluate the justice's/judge's courtesy and freedom from arrogance and whether the justice/judge manifests human understanding and compassion.
- *Diligence:* Please evaluate whether the justice/judge is prepared for court proceedings, works diligently, and is reasonably prompt in making decisions.
- Overall Evaluation: Please provide your overall assessment of the justice's/judge's performance.

Respondents assigned ratings for each domain using a five-point Likert scale that ranged from *Poor* (1) to *Excellent* (5). Detailed descriptions of the meaning of each point on the Likert scale were provided:

### Confidentiality and Data Safety

The survey introduction included a statement that reassured respondents of the confidentiality of their responses. Confidentiality is also a paramount concern at CBHRS and translated into specific procedures related to data security. Because data such as those collected through the judicial retention survey are of a sensitive nature, CBHRS has rigorous procedures to protect

data. Specifically, paper surveys are kept in a lockable file cabinet located in a secure data storage room. Data are kept locked at all times except when being used for data entry or related purposes. Organizational policies and procedures highlight the requirement for confidentiality and ensure that only staff involved with the project have access to the data. Online data and data that have been entered from paper surveys are maintained on a secure server.

### Assurance of Non-Duplicate Responding

To ensure that as few duplicates or invalid surveys as possible were received, clear instructions were provided to potential paper survey respondents regarding how to handle the survey booklets:

"A postage-paid business reply envelope is enclosed for the return of your completed evaluations. Place the completed survey inside the envelope marked "Confidential," and seal the envelope. Then use the business reply envelope, being sure to sign in the space provided. The return envelope MUST BE SIGNED in order for your survey to be counted."

Based on these instructions, CBHRS implemented procedures to ensure that only one survey was counted for each respondent. If a survey had been returned without a name on the outside envelope, the envelope would have been opened to ascertain whether the individual signed the comment section. No paper surveys were returned without a name on the outside of the envelope. Signed names on the envelopes were compared to the mailing list, ensuring the individual was an eligible participant. Each individual's unique identifier was entered with the data, providing the ability to check for duplication with the completed online surveys.

Had any paper surveys been returned without signatures, with illegible signatures, or without being on the mailing list they would have been excluded from the data entry and analysis and not reflected in the total number of surveys received. No surveys were returned that were not on the list or signed.

For the online data collection, each potential respondent was provided with a unique URL that could only be used once, and only accessed from the e-mail address to which it was sent. After merging online and entered paper data, CBHRS analyzed frequencies of the unique identifier variable to identify any duplicate responses. Three duplicate surveys were identified. For each set of duplicate surveys, the earlier completed data was retained; completion data was based on online survey initiation date and the data accompanying the paper survey signature. In cases where the respondent did not date the paper survey, the more complete survey data was retained. The duplicate survey was removed, ensuring that only one survey per respondent was used in the data analysis.

#### Data Management

With the goal of virtually error-free data handling, CBHRS implemented rigorous data entry procedures to ensure the accuracy of data entry. Paper data was entered using an electronic system similar to the online survey that prevents out-of-range responses. Before entry, all paper data was reviewed and cleaned prior to data entry. Then, a second staff member confirmed all data cleaning and entered the surveys. After the paper surveys were entered, the first staff

member verified all entries and corrected any mistakes. Online data were downloaded from the survey website and imported into SPSS for analysis. The paper survey responses were merged with the online responses in SPSS to create one data file of all responses.

#### Results

Two sets of results are presented in this section of the report. First, respondents' level of experience with each justice/judge is shown. Second, ratings and comparisons of the justices/judges are provided in a variety of ways. Many of the cross tabulations yield results based on small numbers of respondents. Results based on small numbers of respondents should be regarded with caution and more weight given to the overall results.

In all summary tables, justice/judges appear in order based on court/district. Within each district, superior court judges appear first and are followed by district court judges.

#### Respondents' Level of Experience with Each Justice/Judge

All respondents were asked to describe the basis of their evaluation for each justice/judge they rated, with options of direct professional experience, professional reputation, and other personal contacts.

Table 3 shows the type of experience of respondents for each justice/judge.

#### Ratings of Justices/Judges

In the tables that follow, responses to the rating questions are shown in a variety of ways. Most tables show the number of respondents (*n*) and the average rating (*M*). Tables 4-9 present detail on the *Overall Rating* item. Table 4 compares all justice/judge ratings to those from respondents with direct professional experience and includes the median rating (*Mdn*) and the standard deviation (*SD*) in addition to number of respondents and average. Tables 5-9 present data only from those respondents who indicated direct professional experience. Table 5 provides justices'/judges' mean scores broken down by respondents' type of practice. Table 6 provides justices'/judges' mean scores broken down by respondents' type of caseload handled. Table 8 provides justices'/judges' mean scores broken down by respondents' type of practice. Table 9 provides justices'/judges' mean scores broken down by respondents' type of caseload handled.

For each individual justice/judge, Tables 10-75 provide a demographics summary of respondents and detailed information on ratings provided by respondent characteristic.
