Public Hearing about Judges on the Ballot in November Tuesday, May 22, 2018 - 4:30 p.m.

As required by Alaska law, the Alaska Judicial Council is evaluating the seventeen judges in all areas of the state who are eligible to be on the ballot this November. On **Tuesday, May 22, 2018 at 4:30 p.m.**, the Council will hold a statewide public hearing to solicit comments about these judges (see list below). Members of the public are invited to participate by attending their local **Legislative Information Office from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. (for locations go to their website at www.akleg.gov)** or by calling **1-844-586-9085** (toll free), **907-586-9085** (if calling from Juneau), or **907-563-9085** (if calling from Anchorage). The Council is interested to hear about the judges' legal ability, fairness, diligence, integrity, temperament and overall performance. The Council will vote on its retention recommendations on June 12, 2018.
