

I have been on the Anchorage District Court for approximately 5 years. I was a magistrate judge and standing master in Glennallen prior to coming to Anchorage and I was a private attorney in Valdez prior to my appointment in Glennallen. I have been in Alaska since 1995 and still spend quite a bit of time in the interior. I have enjoyed my time on the Anchorage District Court. The District Court is where most people first experience a courtroom and where many people come before the Court without an attorney. I believe it is important for people who come to court to have the feeling that they have been heard. Listening is an important part of our job and can be one of the most challenging parts of our job.

In my position I see people at their most stressful time, at a time when their world may be falling apart, at a time when they may have been the victim of a crime they cannot understand. The hope is that, as a court, we can offer a venue where people's problems can be addressed and their concerns can be heard. It is this aspect of our mission that motivates me on a daily basis.
