I have been honored to serve as a district court judge in Anchorage. With my experience, I have learned to balance the need to render timely, well-reasoned decisions with the importance of allotting sufficient time for the parties and the public to understand the process and the rationale behind my decisions. I've also developed the knowledge and insight to readily adjust to the varying needs of the litigants in a kind and respectful manner that honors due process and the rule of law.

The demands presented by the pace and volume of the caseload in district court offer frequent opportunities to engage in meaningful interactions with the public. Much of my work involves explaining foundational concepts of our legal system to those who need more understanding or feel intimidated by the process. I welcome these exchanges, as they present the opportunity to instill public faith and trust in the justice system.

During my term, I've also had the challenging and rewarding experience of sitting as a pro tempore judge on various superior courts and several cases before the Alaska Court of Appeals. These experiences have challenged me professionally and allowed me to foster new relationships with my colleagues on other courts.

Outside the courtroom, I serve on several court committees focused on judicial education and improving access to the courts for all Alaskans. Additionally, I completed a judicial fellowship focused on enhancing judicial skills in domestic violence cases and increasing access for victims from underrepresented groups. I have since worked to simplify protective order forms and instructions and improve language access, especially in rural courts with high rates of domestic violence and sexual assault.
