My broad array of experience in both criminal and civil litigation makes me a good candidate for a position on the Anchorage Superior Court or Palmer District Court. I have been fortunate to work as both a civil and criminal litigator in Alaska for more than a decade. This experience further solidified my deep, longstanding belief in the rule of law and also provided me with a broad understanding of both criminal and civil practice. My current position as a prosecutor has allowed me to handle high-stakes criminal trials. Because of the nature of the cases I handle, many of my recent trials remain on appeal. This experience has provided me with the practical experience that trial judges need and a firm understanding of the procedural and evidentiary rules. In addition, I have litigated multiple post-conviction relief applications and handled several appellate matters before the Alaska Court of Appeals. I have also gained a better understanding of how victims are impacted by the criminal justice system and seen first-hand the need for treating them with dignity and respect.

Additional Comments (Continued)

My time as a Superior Court law clerk in Palmer helped me understand and gain great respect for the judicial system and process, especially in Palmer. Not only was I able to learn how to efficiently maintain a judicial docket, I was able to gain a behind-the-scenes look at various judges' exercise of courtroom control to ensure the integrity and fairness to all interested parties.

I worked on a variety of complex cases involving personal injury, insurance contracts, workers' compensation, employment law, medical malpractice, small claims, and admiralty law during my time as a civil litigator as both defense and plaintiff's counsel. I conducted depositions and engaged in complex pre-trial litigation in these cases. I watched and learned from experienced trial attorneys that taught me how to better prepare, issue spot, and analyze cases prior to trial. This experience will benefit my ability to be a well-prepared Superior Court Judge and spot issues being raised by litigating parties that need to be addressed to make a complete and accurate court record.

I believe the legal system is a vital and fundamental role in our society and that a fair and impartial court is critical in furthering public trust in the law. As a lifelong Alaskan, it is important to me that the community in which I have grown and love has a fair, accessible, and impartial court system.
