Judicial Council Recommendation

The Alaska Judicial Council, a non-partisan citizens commission established by the Alaska constitution, evaluates judges on a number of criteria, including their legal ability, demeanor, their diligence, their ability to manage their caseloads, and their fairness and integrity. The Judicial Council finds Judge Tan to be *Qualified* and recommends unanimously that the public vote "YES" to retain him as a superior court judge.

Judicial Council Evaluation

The Judicial Council surveyed 3,036 attorneys, 1,492 peace and probation officers, social workers/guardians ad litem, and child advocates, jurors, and court employees about the judges on the ballot. Respondents were asked to rate judicial performance and to submit comments. The Council also reviewed the ratings and observations of the Alaska Judicial Observers, independent community-based volunteers. The Council reviewed court system records concerning peremptory challenges, recusals, and appellate affirmance and reversal rates; any civil or criminal litigation involving the judge; APOC and court system conflict-of-interest statements; any disciplinary files; and whether a judge's pay was withheld for an untimely decision. The Council investigated judicial conduct in specific cases. The Council interviewed some judges, attorneys, court staff, and others. The Council held a statewide public hearing to obtain comments about judges.

Summary of Survey Information

Attorneys in Alaska rated Judge Tan on the six categories summarized in the table above, using 5 as the highest rating possible. The attorney rating for Judge Tan on overall performance was 4.3. Peace and probation officers rated Judge Tan on five categories, using the 5-point scale above. They gave Judge Tan a rating of 3.7.

Four other groups also evaluated Judge Tan's performance, using the same 5-point scale with 5 as the highest rating. Jurors rated him 5.0, court employees gave him 4.7, and social workers, guardians ad litem and CASA volunteers rated him at 3.9. The Alaska Judicial Observers rated him 3.8.

Recommendation: Vote "YES" to retain Judge Sen K.Tan

Answer to Question 1 (b).

I average 2-3 jury trials per year and 30-40 non-jury trials per year, including divorce, custody, and child-in-need-of-aid cases.

In addition to managing my Anchorage caseload, I was until recently the traveling judge for the Valdez Court, and I am presently the traveling judge for the Cordova Court.

Answer to Question 3.

It has been my pleasure and privilege to serve as a Superior Court Judge in Anchorage. There is no better job.

During my nine years on the bench, the civil caseload has shifted from the standard disputes (personal injury, contract, property) to predominantly domestic cases and child-in-need-of-aid cases. Most civil cases do not go to trial, but instead generally settle after the discovery motions and dispositive motions have been decided. Over the years the number of pro se litigants has also increased.

Because of the way my caseload has evolved, most of my elective judicial education has been focused on domestic and children's cases. Recently I attended the National Association of Counsel for Children Conference, and the National Drug Court Institute. In addition, my membership on the Domestic Violence Committee has given me insight into one of the most troubling societal issues. I have also pursued my interest in assessing credibility, and attended a daylong training course on evaluating truthfulness with Dr. Paul Ekman's group. This is particularly relevant as non-jury trials far outnumber jury trials.

In addition, I am one of two judges assigned to the Family Care Court, a therapeutic court that convenes every Tuesday afternoon. The goal of the court is to protect children by providing a structured setting for parents in recovery.

In all, I believe I have matured as a judge, with the continuing goal of striving to be fair to all litigants while giving each individual case the attention it deserves.

Evaluation of Judge Sen K. Tan: Alaska Bar Association Members

Summary of Findings

Judge Sen K. Tan was evaluated by 531 Alaska Bar Association members who reported having direct professional experience with the judge. The mean score on *overall* evaluation was 4.3. The highest mean score was obtained on *integrity* (4.6) and the lowest score was obtained on *diligence* (4.2). Details are present in the two tables that follow.


